The use of Photographs in the program:

Photographs taken of enrolled children may be used in the following applications:

Informationally:

To send updates to parents. (Photographs where the child's face is not visible may still be used internally or externally).

Internally:

School Newsletters, Bulletin Boards, Parent Facebook Group, Cubbies, ETC. Their first name may be used.

Externally:

School Website, Marketing Material, etc. Permission will be obtained either verbally or via text prior to each individual photo being used. Their first name may be used.

Animal Care and Handling:

It is understood that enrolled children will occasionally get the opportunity to learn how to properly care for and handle the animals housed at The Birds Nest. All interactions will be closely monitored; however, animals, even under the best circumstances, can be unpredictable. In the event that a child is injured, steps will be followed according to emergency policy and procedures listed in the handbook. It is also understood that, unless the incident is the result of poor monitoring, The Birds Nest will not be held accountable. All animals are current on their vaccinations, in accordance with state regulations.

- ❖ Mr. Peppers (DOB 8/14/2013) A male declawed cat who is extremely patient with children and spends most of his time sleeping out of reach of the children.
- ❖ Mavis (DOB 8/28/2015) A female Boxador (Boxer-Lab) who is also extremely gentle and careful around the children. Most of the day she does not come in contact with the children. She has her own yard. On occasion she will sneak a visit and politely ask the children to throw her ball.

Walking and Emergency Transportation:

Transportation of enrolled children may be conducted in the following applications:

Walking Field Trips: By sign this document, I give permission for my child to accompany his/her class on all walking field trips planned and supervised by The Birds Nest. Staff will ensure a safe walking route and supervision to/from the school. I understand that no such field trip will take place without a safe ratio of adults to children and I will be notified prior to any walking field trips.
